

### June 21 | Board the *mv Victory I* in Chicago

### June 22 | Cruising Lake Michigan

### June 23 | Mackinac Island

Delight in the Mackinac Island's charming Victoria-era ambience on a horse-drawn carriage tour and see handsome turn-of-the-century homes built by early captains of American industry. Tour Fort Mackinac to learn about its role during the War of 1812. Then take in the views from the Grand Hotel's verandah and enjoy the Grand Luncheon Buffet. Meals B+L+D

### June 24 | The Soo Locks + Sault Ste. Marie

You might wish to arise early this morning as we transit through the Soo Locks. This afternoon, enjoy the tour of your choice on either the Canadian or U.S. side of the border: On the Canadian side, guests visit the Bush Plane Heritage Center. On the American side, you'll tour the unique Valley Camp Museum, set in the hold of a cargo ship that plied these waters from 1917 to 1966. Meals B+L+D

### June 25 | Manitoulin Island

This morning we'll sail into beautiful Georgian Bay to step ashore on Manitoulin, the largest freshwater island in the world. Visit the Immaculate Conception Church, a focal point of island life, and explore the Ojibwe Cultural Foundation. A drum and dance performance offers further insight into the island's indigenous Ojibwe culture. Meals B+L+D

### June 26 | Cruising Lake Huron

Another fine day of cruising is enhanced by talks with our onboard experts, congenial meals and our ship's Open Bar. Meals B+L+D

### June 27 | Henry Ford Museum

Today we'll visit the Henry Ford Museum where fascinating exhibits include the limousine that transported John F. Kennedy through Dallas on November 22, 1963 and the bus on which Rosa Parks refused to give up her seat in 1955. Meals B+L+D

### June 28 | Discover Cleveland

At the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame, set in a striking landmark designed by I. M. Pei, we'll explore the evolution of the musical genre that shaped a generation and track its cultural impact. We'll also visit the lively West Side Market. Meals B+L+D

### June 29 | Niagara Falls

Enjoy the vineyard-laced landscapes of the Niagara Peninsula. Later, a thrilling Hornblower Cruise takes you into the Great Niagara Gorge, past thundering Bridal Veil Falls, and into the heart of Horseshoe Falls! After a wine-tasting and lunch, you can explore Niagara-on-the-Lake before we reboard our ship. Meals B+L+D
