LAND TOUR



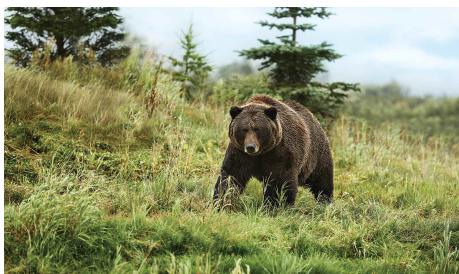
Day 1 - Tuesday, July 29, 2025 Arrive in Anchorage, Alaska

Arrive in Anchorage and get settled in the Hotel Captain Cook for an overnight stay. You might enjoy getting out to see the shops, restaurants and cultural attractions of this metropolitan city.



Day 2 - Wednesday, July 30, 2025 Denali Princess Wilderness Lodge

This morning, you'll head for the Denali Princess Wilderness Lodge via a scenic motor-coach drive. Located just a mile from the entrance to Denali National Park, the lodge is the perfect base camp for exploring the area.



Day 3 - Thursday, July 31, 2025 Denali Princess Wilderness Lodge

Explore Denali National Park on a Natural History Tour watching for glimpses of Denali and Denali's "Big Five"; moose, bears, caribou, Dall sheep and wolves. Later today, you may want to check out the Denali Visitors Center or simply relax with a glass of wine on the deck overlooking the Nenana River.

Day 4 - Friday, August 1, 2025 Denali Princess Wilderness Lodge

You have a full day to enjoy a variety of excursions like a husky homestead tour, river rafting, hiking, or glacier flightseeing. Or you may enjoy the spectacular main lodge, river view deck, and Princess Village with the popular Christmas cottage and sugar shack.



Day 5 - Saturday, August 2, 2025 Anchorage (Whittier), Alaska

Enjoy an 8 hour scenic rail journey through some of the best wilderness on Princess' exclusive Direct-to-the Wilderness rail service toward Whittier. You may enjoy breakfast and/or lunch onboard this double decker train with upper level seating under glass-domed views. Narration and bar service enhance this amazing experience.

Day 6 - Sunday, August 3, 2025 Hubbard Glacier (Scenic Cruising)

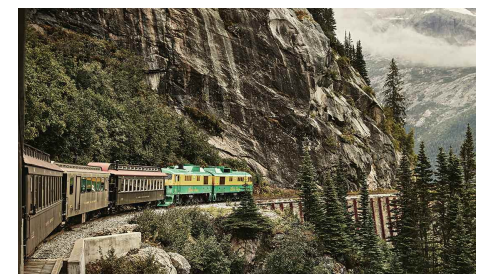
The largest tidewater glacier in North America, Hubbard Glacier measures 76 miles long and

plunges 1,200 feet into the depths of the bay. Its immense beauty and phenomenal blue hues are enchanting, even from afar. But it's when your cruise ship draws closer that its towering surface really impresses, dwarfing even the uppermost deck on your ship at a whopping 40 stories high. There, with the snowcapped mountains serving as a glorious backdrop, you'll have a prime viewing spot from which to witness the glacier calving.



Day 7 - Monday, August 4, 2025 Glacier Bay National Park (Scenic Cruising)

Princess is one of a select few cruise lines permitted to cruise the pristine waters of Glacier Bay, the highlight of your 7-night Voyage of the Glaciers cruise. Park Rangers climb aboard with you to share insight about this breathtaking national park that boasts some of the world's most spectacular tidewater glaciers. Glacier Bay National Park and its epic ice giants are part of a UNESCO World Heritage Site comprising Alaska's magnificent park system.



Day 8 - Tuesday, August 5, 2025 Skagway, Alaska (7am -8:30pm)

Skagway was the gateway to the gold fields for the thousands who flocked to Alaska and the Yukon with the hope of striking it rich. Over 100 years ago, the White Pass route through the Coast Mountains and the shorter but steeper Chilkoot Trail were used by countless stampedes. A recommended excursion in Skagway is the White Pass Scenic Railway. This historic 40-mile roundtrip adventure retraces the original route to the White Pass Summit and takes you up 2,865 feet, through gorges, gulches and tunnels. *(continued on next page)*

Day 9 - Wednesday, August 6, 2025 Juneau, Alaska (6:30am –4pm)

Renowned for three of the largest gold mines in the world, Juneau is the capital of Alaska with some 30,000 people calling it home. Points of interest include Mendenhall Glacier, whale watching, glacier flightseeing, dog sledding and more!

Day 10 - Thursday, August 7, 2024 Ketchikan, Alaska (10am –6pm)

Ketchikan is known as Alaska's "First City" because it's the first major community travelers come to as they journey north. Located on an island, Ketchikan began life as an Indian fishing



camp. Visitors to Ketchikan will be intrigued by its rich Native heritage, which includes the world's oldest collection of totem poles at Totem Heritage Center. Ketchikan, with its abundance of salmon, is also a sportfishing paradise.

Day 11 - Friday, August 8, 2025 At Sea

A day at sea can be an adventure all its own! Spend some time at the spa. Relax in a hot tub. Shop for duty-free souvenirs, or discover somewhere new to eat —there's a wealth of diversions for nearly every interest – and mood onboard Sapphire Princess.



Day 12 - Saturday, August 9, 2025 Vancouver, Canada
